



Dear Parents/Carers

Post 18 Progression Planning

Further to my letter 5 June I am advising you when your son/daughter is scheduled to attend a session on-site to present details of Post 18 Progression Planning. This session is designed to introduce the UCAS application process, personal statement writing and non-university routes such as Apprenticeships. Depending on student subject options, they may miss timetabled lessons on the day. Teachers will be asked to ensure Zoom lesson recordings and details of work covered will be provided in order to keep up to date.

Due to the ongoing guidance and restrictions regarding the numbers of students we are able to have on site, we need to carefully monitor the access arrangements and venues used. Students are allocated a time and room to attend. We are not in a position to allow students to choose sessions and I refer you to the Return to School document sent last week.

Any student who has declared on the recent surveys they are not able to come onto site, a pre-recorded Zoom 'lesson' will be provided. This will give them with the same information but tutors will need to support them with follow-up work regarding personal statement writing via Zoom and email.
